

**ORDINANCE NO. 3643**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SOMERSET AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, MORE PARTICULARLY CHAPTER 226 - VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 226-31 – CONTROL OF MOVEMENT AND PARKING ON PUBLIC AND BOARD OF EDUCATION PROPERTY.**

**SUMMARY**

An ordinance amending the Vehicles & Traffic Ordinance as follows: Add the following Section as Code Section 226-31A (1) (c):

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

(c) Pine Grove Manor School Bus Frontage Road off Phillips Road.

- [1] Said roadway shall be one way with all authorized traffic traveling in a northbound direction entering on the southern access and exiting on the northern access.
- [2] No person shall park an unauthorized vehicle at any time on either curbline. An authorized vehicle shall be an authorized, registered, school vehicle of the type to transport students to and from school.
- [3] Any vehicle parked in violation shall be subject to removal at the expense of the owner.

**SECTION I**

**Chapter 226, Vehicles & Traffic, Section 226-31, Control of Movement and Parking on Public and Board of Education Properties, Subsection A – Regulation for the Movement and Parking of Traffic on Municipal and Board of Education Property** is amended to add the following:

**226-31. Control of movement and parking on public and Board of Education properties.**

A. Regulation for the movement and parking of traffic on municipal and Board of Education property. [Amended 11-23-1993 by Ord. No. 1803; 5-23-2006 by Ord. No. 3610]

(1) Pursuant to the authority granted by N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.46, no person shall park or operate a vehicle within the Municipal Complex, 475 DeMott Lane, Somerset, NJ, and Board of Education property except in accordance with Site Plan of such complex on file with the Township Clerk.

(a) Municipal Complex.

- [1] Parking. All vehicles must park only in designated areas and between the lines provided.
- [2] Through streets. The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as through streets. Stop signs shall be installed on the near right side of each street intersecting the through street.

**Name of**

**Street      Limits**

Road “A”      From a point 15 feet west of DeMott Lane to the Road “D”/Road “F” intersection

Road “D”      From a point 15 feet west of DeMott Lane to a point 15 feet north of the Road “A”/Road “F” intersection

[3] Speed limits.

- [a] The speed limit for both directions of traffic in the parking lots shall be 15 miles per hour.

- [b] The speed limit for both directions of travel on the entire lengths of Roads "A," "B," "C," "D," "E" and "F" is 15 miles per hour;
  - [c] Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-designated speed limits authorized by the Department of Transportation.
- [4] Tow-away. Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exitways, loading zones, oil fills, any grass area, pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense.
- [5] Reserved parking. The parking lots described below are reserved parking for various types of vehicles which must be properly identified as per site plan:
- [a] Public Safety Building Parking Lot "G": for police vehicles.
  - [b] Public Safety Building Parking Lot "H": for employees.
  - [c] Public Safety Building Parking Lot "K": for police vehicles only.
  - [d] Municipal Building Lot "J": for municipal vehicles and employees except that the first 14 stalls beginning at the southwest corner and continuing northwest for 126 feet shall be designated visitor parking.
  - [e] Municipal Building Lot "A": for visitors (except between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. for Councilmembers only).
  - [f] Municipal Building Lot "B": for municipal vehicles.
  - [g] Three slots on the north side of Road "C" east of the intersection of Road "C" and Road "D" (reserved for bicycles, motorcycles and compact vehicles).
  - [h] Public Safety Building Parking Lot "N": for police vehicles.
  - [i] Eleven stalls on the southside for Road "E" alongside the Community/Senior Center: for employees.

- [6] Restricted parking. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Roads "A," "B," "C," "D," "E" and "F"	Both	Entire length, except for two handicapped spaces and three visitor spaces on west side of Road "B" and six spaces easterly/northerly side of Road "C" reserved for emergency vehicles

- [7] One-way streets. The following described street is hereby designated as one-way in the direction indicated. Parking on this street will be permitted only on the side indicated below:

Name of Street	Direction	Limit	Parking Permitted
Road "B"	Northbound	From prolongation of the north curbline of Road "A" to the south curbline of Road "D"	Two handicapped spaces and three visitor spaces on the west side
Road "C"	Westbound	From prolongation of the north curbline of Road "A" to the east curbline of Road "D"	Six spaces on east/north side for emergency vehicles only

- [8] Pedestrian crosswalks. The following locations are hereby designated as crosswalks:
- [a] Across Road "A" beginning 117 1/2 feet west of the Road "C"

intersection and extending eight feet south therefrom.

- [b] Across Road "A" beginning at a point 217 feet west of the Road "C" intersection and extending 12 feet therefrom.
  - [c] Across Road "C" beginning at a point 76 feet from Road "A" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [d] Across Road "C" beginning from a point 168 feet of the Road "A" intersection and extending eight feet therefrom.
  - [e] Across Road "A" beginning at a point 20 feet east of the Road "D" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [f] Across Road "C" beginning at a point 21 1/2 feet westerly of the Road "D" and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [g] Across Road "D" beginning at a point 58 feet north of the Road "E" intersection and extending 10 feet therefrom.
  - [h] Across Road "D" beginning at a point 428 feet northwesterly of the DeMott Lane intersection and extending eight feet therefrom.
  - [i] Across Road "D" beginning 280 feet northwest of the DeMott Lane intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [j] Across Road "D" beginning 122 feet northeast of the Road "E" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [k] Across Road "D" beginning 15 feet north of the Road "C" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [l] Across Road "D" beginning 30 feet south of the Road "C" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [m] Across Road "F" beginning 73 feet southwest of the Road "D" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [n] Across westerly driveway of Lot "L" beginning 15 feet south of the Road "A" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
  - [o] Across easterly driveway of Lot "L" beginning 15 feet south of the Road "A" intersection and extending six feet therefrom.
- [9] No-passing zones: Roads "A," "B," "C," "D," "E" and "F" as indicated on site plan.
- [10] Turn prohibitions. No person shall make a turn at any location listed:

<b>Intersection</b>	<b>Turn Prohibition</b>	<b>Movement Prohibited</b>
Road "D" and Road "B"	Right	Eastbound on Road "D" onto southbound Road "B"

- (b) Commerce Drive/Dahmer Road emergency access right-of-way. No person shall operate a vehicle on the Township property located between the westerly terminus of Commerce Drive and the easterly side of Dahmer Road.

(c) *Pine Grove Manor School Bus Frontage Road off Phillips Road.*

- [1] *Said roadway shall be one way with all authorized traffic traveling in a northbound direction entering on the southern access and exiting on the northern access.*
- [2] *No person shall park an unauthorized vehicle at any time on either curbline. An authorized vehicle shall be an authorized, registered, school vehicle of the type to transport students to and from school.*
- [3] *Any vehicle parked in violation shall be subject to removal at the expense of the owner.*

**SECTION II**

Each clause, section or subsection of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate provision to the intent that if any such clause, section or subsection should be declared invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

### **SECTION III**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.

### **SECTION IV**

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
