

ORDINANCE NO. 3744

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN IN THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY MORE PARTICULARLY CHAPTER 384, WATER , ARTICLE XII, OTHER REGULATIONS, SECTION 384-62, WAIVER OF FEES - ADDITION OF PROVISION THAT FEES ARE WAIVED ON PROJECTS THAT ARE TOWNSHIP SUPPORTED THROUGH GRANT FUNDING.

SUMMARY

An ordinance amending Chapter 384, Water, Article XII, Other Regulations, Section 384-62, Waiver of Fees by adding the provision that fees are waived on projects that are Township supported through grant funding.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the Code of the Township of Franklin be and it is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I

Chapter 384, Water - Article XII, Other Regulations is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE XII, Other Regulations

§ 384-60. Water system connections.

All connections to the water system shall be installed in accordance with the Plumbing Code of the Township of Franklin and the applicable local and state regulations regarding water supply. However, employees of the Water Division of the Department of Public Works shall be empowered to make such taps, installations and corrections in the water system as may be necessary to correct operation of the public water system of the Township of Franklin.

§ 384-61. Additional rules and regulations.

The Township Manager is hereby authorized to issue such further rules and regulations as may be necessary to effectively administer the general policy of this chapter. Such rules and regulations must be issued in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 5, Administrative of Government, of the Code of the Township of Franklin.

§ 384-62. Waiver of fees ~~when general water emergency declared.~~

A. Declaration of Water Emergency

In situations where the Health Officer declares a general water emergency, the following fees may be waived by resolution of the Township Council (effective April 28, 2004):

- A. 1. Well abandonment fee as stated in § 384-7E.
- B. 2. Curb connection capital fees as stated in § 384-19.
- C. 3. Curb connection tap fees as stated in § 384-19E(1).
- D. 4. Meter charges as stated in § 384-20.

B. Special Circumstances

In situations where a non-profit project is supported by the Township of Franklin and funded by grant monies, may be waived by resolution of the Township Council:

- 1. Well abandonment fee as stated in § 384-7E.
- 2. Curb connection capital fees as stated in § 384-19.
- 3. Curb connection tap fees as stated in § 384-19E(1).
- 4. Meter charges as stated in § 384-20.

SECTION II

Each clause, section or subsection of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate provision to the intent that if any such clause, section or subsection should be declared invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

SECTION III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
