

ORDINANCE NO. 3771, Amended

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 180, FEES, ARTICLE III, VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS, SECTION 180-6, FEE SCHEDULE.

SUMMARY

An ordinance amending Code Chapter 180, Fees, Vital Statistics Records, Section 180-6, Fee Schedule, increasing birth, marriage and civil union or domestic partnership records to \$20.00 per copy; increasing/changing fees for death certificates to \$20.00 for the first copy and \$5.00 for each additional copy; increase burial permits to \$15.00; add amendments or corrections to vital records at \$20.00.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I

Article III, Vital Statistics Records, Section 180-6, Fee Schedule of Chapter 180, Fees, of the Township of Franklin, is hereby amended as follows:

180-6. Fee schedule. [Amended 4-11-1989 by Ord. No. 1478; 6-12-1990 by Ord. No. 1576; 2-10-2004 by Ord. No. 3418; 4-13-2004 by Ord. No. 3443; 8-10-2004 by Ord. 3480; 3-22-2005 by Ord. No. 3533]

The following schedule of fees is hereby established for obtaining copies of the vital statistics records under the jurisdiction of the Department of Health of the Township. Effective January 1, 2004, standardized safety paper must be used for certified copies of vital records:

- A. Vital records
 - (1) birth, ~~death~~ or marriage, *civil union or domestic partnership*: \$10 20 per copy.
 - (2) *death certificates: \$20 for the first copy and \$5 for each additional copy*
- B. Burial permit: \$1 15 (effective February 9, 2007). [Amended 3-27-2007 by Ord. No. 3676]
- C. Amendments or corrections to vital records: \$20 each vital record.
- ~~C. Certificate of domestic partnership: \$10 (effective July 12, 2004).~~
- ~~D. Civil union license: \$10 (effective February 19, 2007). [Added 3-27-2007 by Ord. No. 3676]~~

SECTION II

Each clause, section or subsection of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate provision to the intent that if any such clause, section or subsection should be declared invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected.

SECTION III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION VI

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
