

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MUTUAL POLICE AID INTERLOCAL SERVICES
AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Agreements for shared service, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4 et. seq., authorizes any Local Unit of the State to enter into a contract with any other Local Unit or units within the State for the joint provision within their territorial jurisdictions of any service which any party to the Agreement is empowered to render within its own jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, Municipalities of the State of New Jersey are authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:14-156 et seq., in the event of an emergency to provide Police assistance outside their territorial jurisdictions in order to protect life and property or to assist in suppressing a riot or disorder; and,

WHEREAS, the Participating Local Units and **Franklin Township** have determined that it is in their mutual best interest and benefit that each agree to render supplemental police assistance to any Requesting Local Unit pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset does hereby authorize the Mayor and Township Clerk to execute agreements, as prepared by Somerset County Counsel and on file with the Township Clerk to provide police mutual aid services to the County of Somerset municipalities and Somerset County.
