

ORDINANCE NO. 3664

AN ORDINANCE AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, MORE PARTICULARLY CHAPTER 13, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES, ARTICLE XII, HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION, SECTION 13-52, MEMBERSHIP (INCREASE 9 CITIZEN MEMBERS TO 12 CITIZEN MEMBERS.)

SUMMARY

An Ordinance amending Chapter 13, Boards, Commissions and Committee to increase membership from nine (9) citizen members to twelve (12) citizen members.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Franklin in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I.

The Municipal Code of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset, New Jersey is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE XII, Human Relations Commission [Amended 1-14-1997 by Ord. No. 1990 (§ 3-62 of the 1990 Code)]

§ 13-50. Creation and appointment authority.

The Township Human Relations Commission, heretofore created by ordinance pursuant to general law, is continued with the functions, powers and duties prescribed by general law and ordinance. The Council shall appoint the members of the Commission, who shall serve without compensation.

§ 13-51. Purpose.

The Human Relations Commission shall attempt to foster, through community effort or otherwise, good will, cooperation and conciliation among the groups and elements of the inhabitants of the community.

§ 13-52. Membership.

There is hereby created a Human Relations Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-10, consisting of ~~nine~~ twelve citizen members to be appointed by the Township Council for a term of three years and until their successors have been duly appointed and have qualified. In the event of a vacancy during an unexpired term of office, a person shall be appointed as a member of said body to serve for such unexpired term. In addition, the Township Council shall appoint from its membership one Councilman to serve a liaison to the Human Relations Commission for a term of one year.

**SECTION II.
Severability.**

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION III.
Inconsistent Ordinances Repealed.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION IV.
Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
