

**RESOLUTION APPROVING DONATION OF ABANDONED BICYCLES TO
FREETOWN, SIERRA LEONE**

WHEREAS, the Police Department is currently in possession of a number of bicycles that have been found abandoned throughout the Township that have gone unclaimed; and

WHEREAS, the current number of bicycles in storage has exceeded the Township's storage capacity and unsuccessful efforts have been made to locate a charity; and

WHEREAS, the government of Freetown, Sierra Leone has expressed an interest in taking all of the bicycles, no matter the condition, to send to said bicycles to those in need in Sierra Leone; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that it hereby gives permission to donate all unclaimed bicycles held in storage by the Franklin Township Police Department to the government of Freetown, Sierra Leone.
