

**RESOLUTION OPPOSING CLOSURE OF DISTRICT POSTAL OFFICE LOCATED IN EDISON, NJ**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Postal Service has announced plans to move mail sorting operations currently performed at the Kilmer P&DC Facility in Edison to Trenton P&DC in Trenton or Dominick V. Daniels P&DC in Kearny both approximately 30 miles away; and

**WHEREAS**, the closing of the Kilmer P&DC facility would cause mail delays for the residents in Franklin Township;

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Postal Service has failed to provide any evidence that closing the Kilmer P&DC Facility would save money or that the current level of service could be maintained;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Franklin, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that it hereby opposes the closing of the Kilmer P&DC Facility located in Edison, New Jersey;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to Senators Frank Lautenberg and Robert Menendez and to Congressmen Frank Pallone, Leonard Lance, Rodney P. Frelinghuysen and Rush Holt.
