

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF RIVERVIEW DRIVE

BE IT RESOLVED the following described road or portion of road has been dedicated to the Township of Franklin:

RIVERVIEW DRIVE

A 60 feet wide road beginning at its intersection with Apgar Drive and extending southwesterly, along its various courses, a distance of approximately 636 feet to its terminus in a cul-de-sac.

The above named road as laid out on a certain map entitled, "D&P Industrial Park, Franklin township, Somerset County, New Jersey", prepared by Donald H. Stires Associates, Somerville, NJ, dated April 21, 1983, revised to May 5, 1983, and filed in the Somerset County Clerk's Office on June 24, 1983 as Map No. 3029.

WHEREAS, said road or portion of road has been duly inspected by the Township Engineer and the Director of Public Works and determined to be in conformity with applicable Township standards, and said persons have recommended acceptance of such road or portion of road as a municipal road;

NOW, THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Franklin, Somerset County hereby accepts the dedication of the above listed road or portion of road as a municipal road open to the public as of the date of this resolution.
