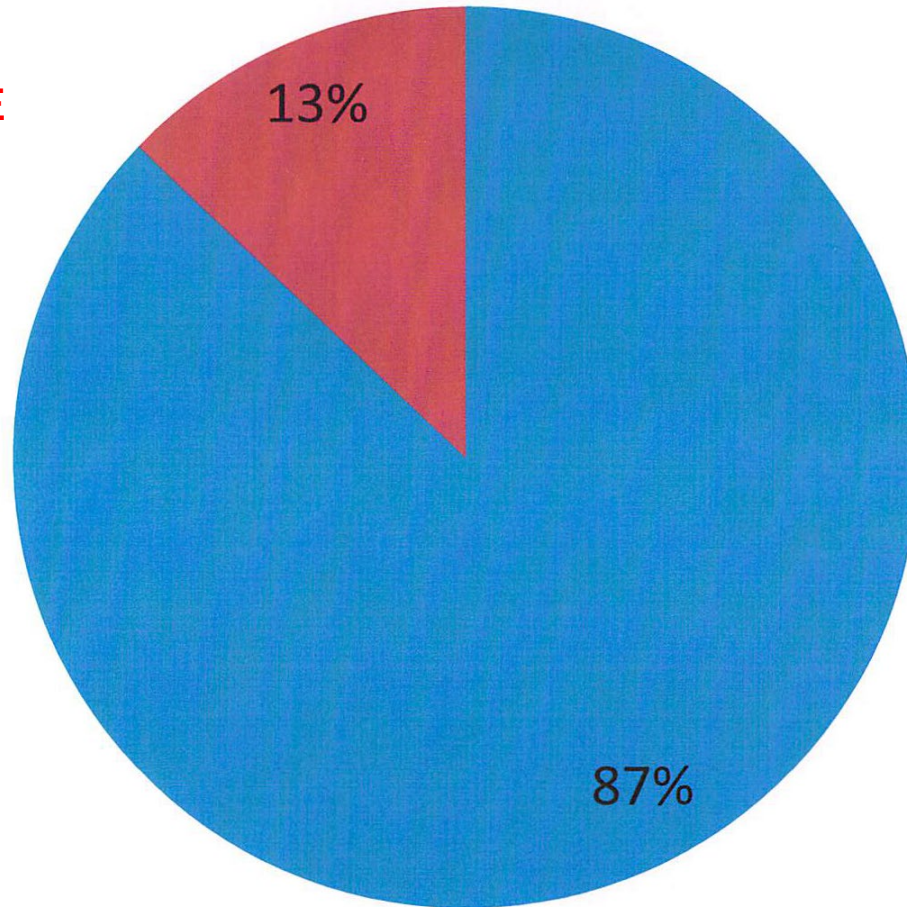

■ Male ■ Female

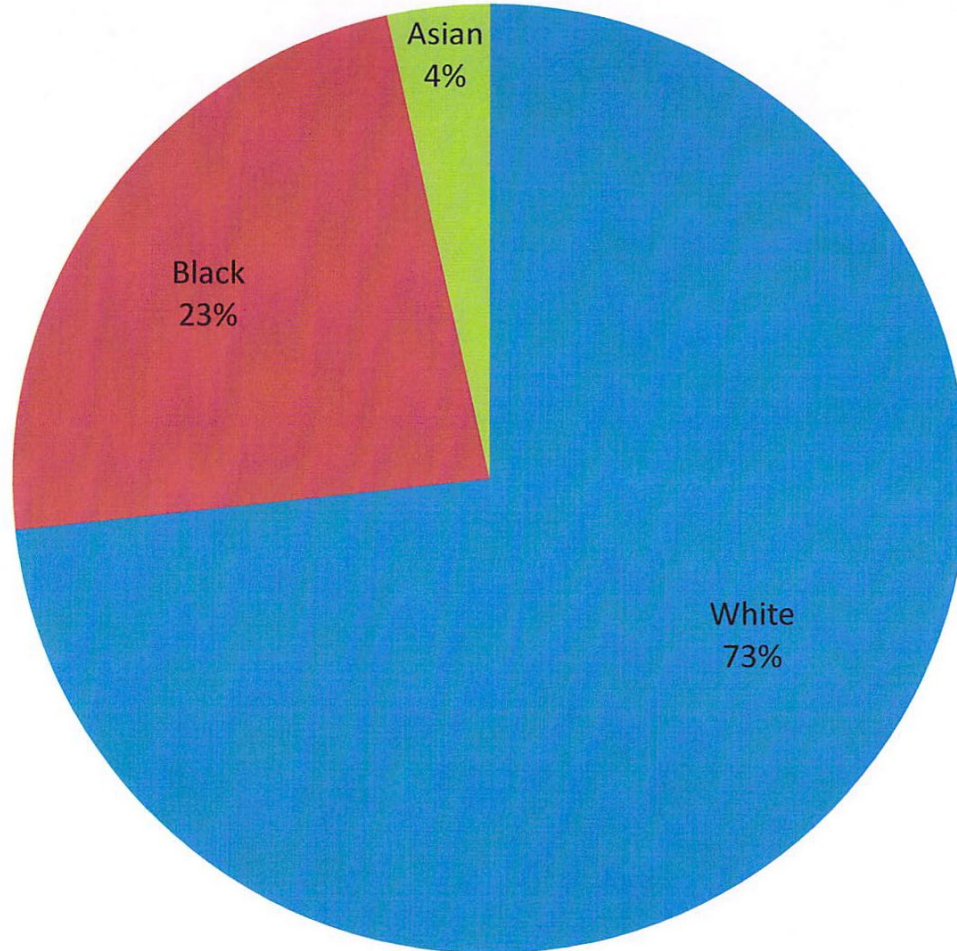

OFFICERS RACE

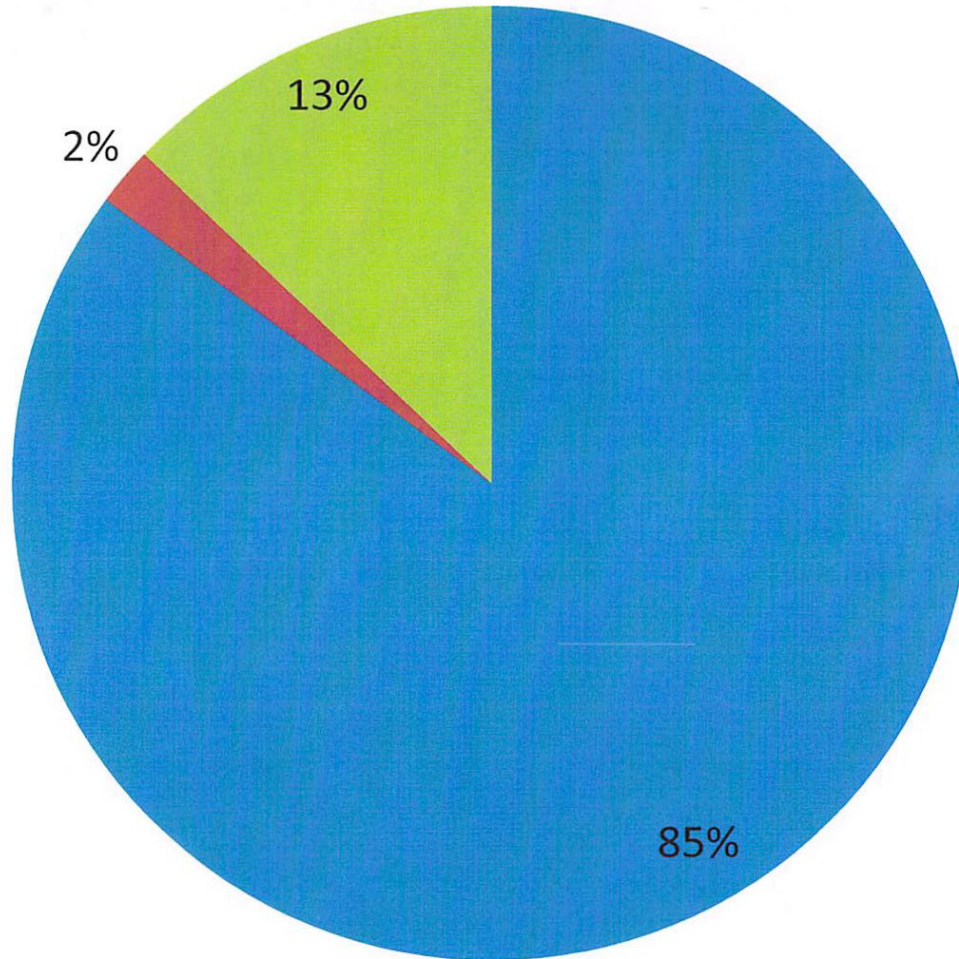

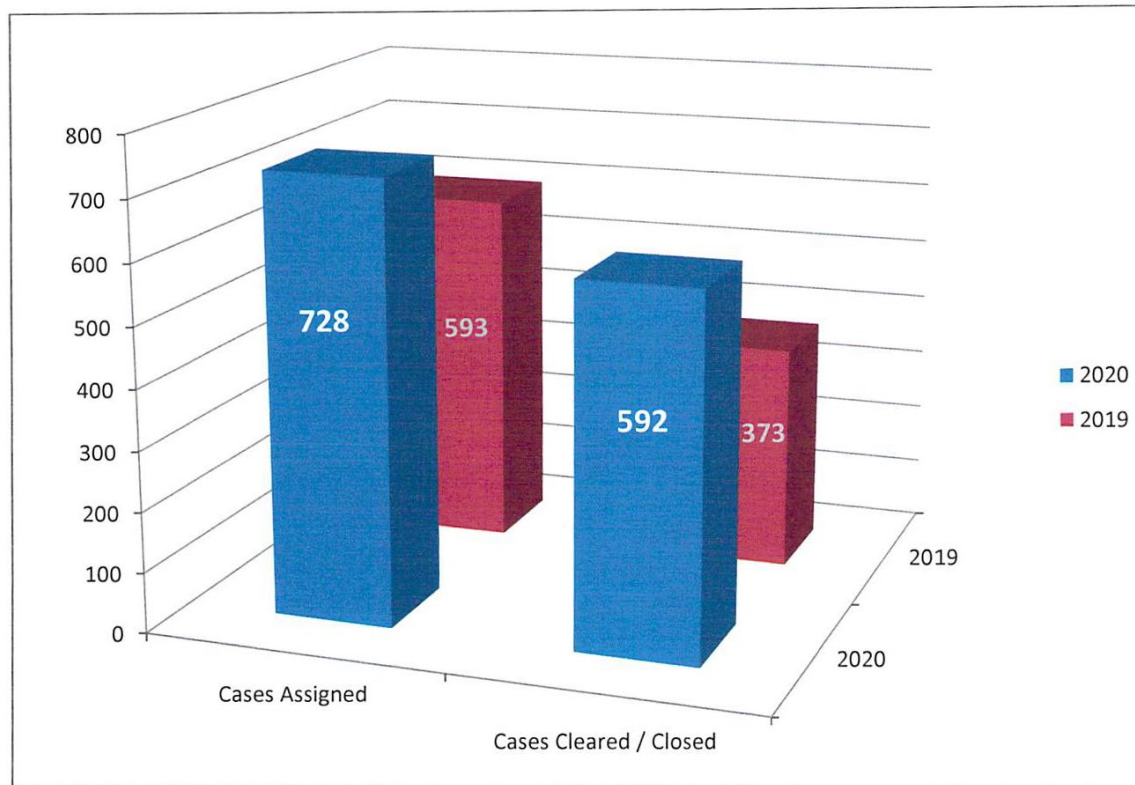

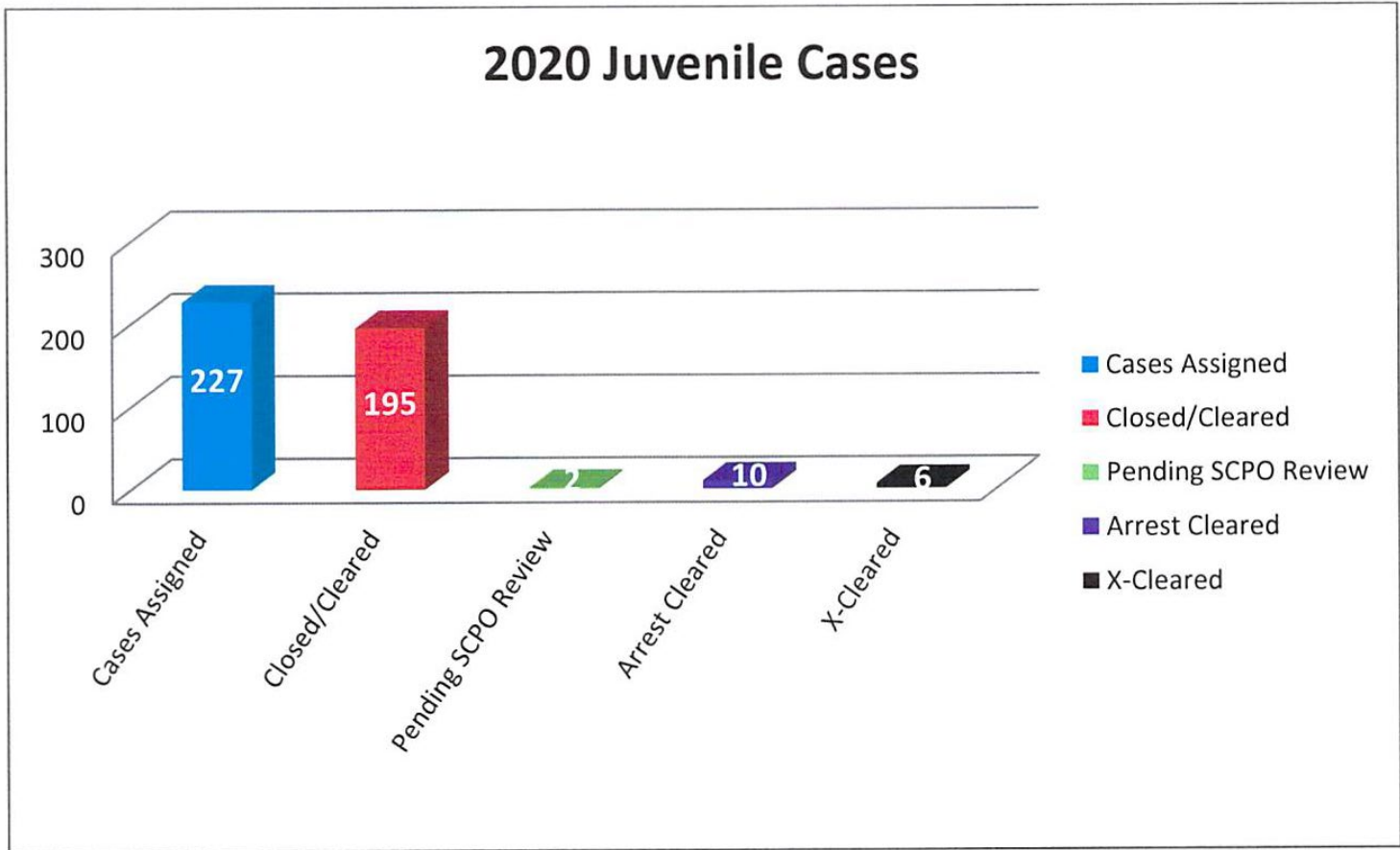


2019 VS **2020**

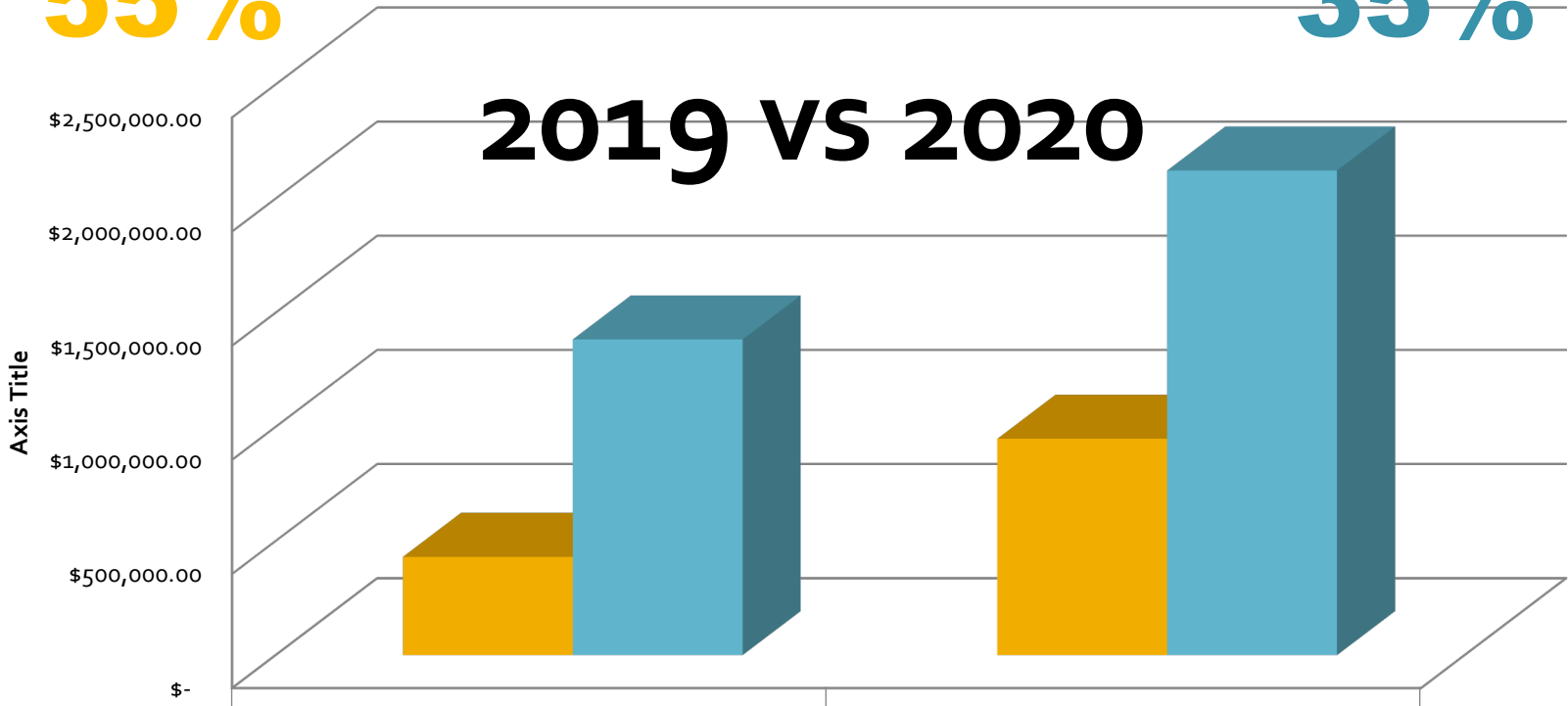
